



MONDAY ART CLASSES CURRICULUM

Nov-Dec 2021

Commencing Mondays for 5 weeks from 1st November – 6th December 2021, 3.30-4.45pm (*please note there is no class on the week of 15th November because of the in-service that week*). The cost is £10.00 per session for the 5-week block, so £50 in total including all materials (15% discount for siblings). Payment in full should be made at the start of the block please and I'm afraid I can't offer money back if your child can't manage for any reason as I have to buy the materials anyway – but I will do my best to provide all materials and instructions for the missed lesson so they can do the activity at home.

I've made a Covid Risk Assessment which I've included at the end of this document. This gives practical details of how the classes will run.

Course outline: This term we will be having fun creating lots of fun things with Christmas in mind! We will develop skills in colour mixing, colour combinations, designing compositions and working in 3-dimensions. We will learn about the beginnings of abstract art in the 20th Century by looking at the artist Wassily Kandinsky. Techniques we will learn about include watercolour painting, collage, marbling and working with clay.

Covid Risk Assessment October 2021

Area	Action
Arrival and Departure	<p>Either the children come down to the studio on their own if allowed, or one parent can drop the child off at the studio door.</p> <p>I will give the children hand sanitiser on entry.</p> <p>Children will be shown to their seat where they will put their own coats over their own chair and keep their bags beside them.</p> <p>For departure, I will walk the children up to the pavement outside the house at 4.45pm and if the child is old enough and consent has been given, they can walk home, otherwise I'll wait until the child has been picked up by a parent/carer.</p>
Distancing	<p>The tables and chairs will be set out so that there is 1m distance between children in different households.</p>
Classroom	<p>The patio door will be left slightly open for ventilation.</p> <p>I have new plastic seats for easier cleaning.</p> <p>I will wear a mask unless guidelines change that mean I'm not required to.</p>
Hygiene	<p>Hand sanitiser will be available in the studio.</p> <p>Seats, tables and touchpoints will be wiped down, and art overalls washed at high temperature after each class.</p> <p>If a child needs the toilet they can go in the house. The toilet will be cleaned thoroughly before & after class, and only used by class members during class time.</p>
Snack	<p>I will provide a snack for children when they arrive to eat at their seat (or they can take their own snack). Students to take their own drink bottle if required.</p>
General Safe Practices	<p>During art class, children will get their own materials (pencils/paper/paint/brushes etc) at their table which they will use for the whole class time.</p> <p>If anyone feels ill I will let the parent know asap.</p>
